



## **Jon Warrenchuk**

### **Senior Scientist & Campaign Manager**

Jon Warrenchuk is a senior scientist and campaign manager at Oceana, the largest international advocacy group working solely to protect the world's oceans. Warrenchuk, based in Oceana's Juneau, Alaska office, has studied the Alaska marine ecosystem for more than fifteen years, including journeys to the bottom of the sea in submarines, rough seas on a Bering Sea crab boat and the eccentricities of Alaskan fish politics.

During his 10 years with Oceana, Warrenchuk has helped to get hundreds of thousands of square miles of ocean habitat protected and usher in a new era of ecosystem-based fisheries management in the North Pacific. He specializes in finding science-based solutions to conservation management problems.

Prior to joining Oceana in 2003, he worked for the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, the National Marine Fisheries Service and the University of Alaska. He has also authored several peer-reviewed scientific publications and reports.

Warrenchuk holds a bachelor's degree in ecology from the University of Calgary and a Master of Science in fisheries from the University of Alaska Fairbanks.
