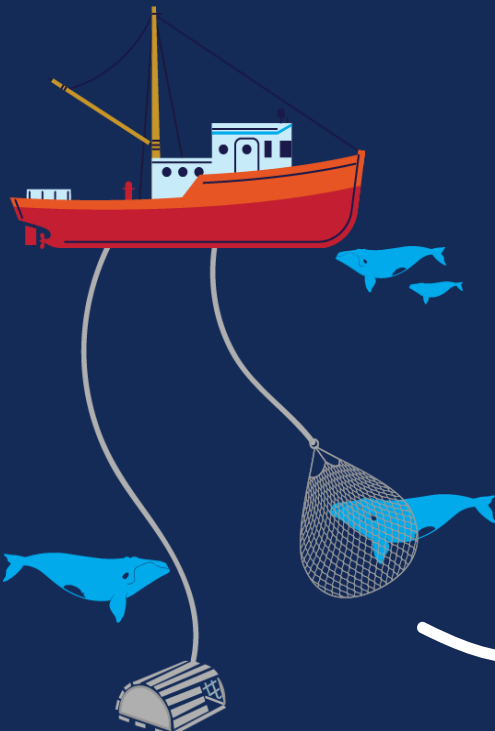
A WHALE-Y BIG ISSUE FOR RIGHT WHALES



The North Atlantic right whale is one of the most endangered whales on the planet.

ONLY AROUND 356 REMAIN.

Strikes from speeding boats can cause serious injuries like cuts, bruising, and broken bones.



A jungle of nearly one million fishing lines sprawls across right whale migration routes and feeding areas, creating a high risk of entanglement.
